Director's Message

I express my heart felt gratitude on releasing fourth issue of Newsletter “Navutkarsh”. I wish for the success of this endeavor. This time, in this column of 'Current Economic Problem' I am writing on inflation & indian economy.



Inflation and Indian Economy

Growth of GDP (Gross Domestic Product) in Indian Economy is not sustaining at 8%. This 8% rate is ideal rate set by NITI

Aayog for current year. There are many factors which block the growth rate like falling of agriculture & industrial productions, increasing budgetary deficit, imbalance of payment, indiscipline in government expenditures and revenues and increasing rate of inflation.

Inflation is a sickness in economy.

It is a imbalance between quantity of money and quantity of goods and services. Quantity of money increases but quantity of goods and services do not increase at desired rate resulting purchasing power of money decreases and general price level of goods increases. Inflation cuts the growth rate, reduces the saving and investment of fixed income persons which create a great dissatisfaction among people against government.

The main causes of inflation are increasing flow of money and declining production, unlawful hoarding and simulated creation of more demand and less supply circle and

increasing of non-budgetary expenditures of government. Desired rate of inflation for Indian economy is 5% but at present this rate is about 8%.

To control and check the inflation RBI takes some policy decisions by a monetary policy. Government and RBI forms monetary policy committee (MPC) of three persons including the governor of RBI. This committee bimonthly review the demand and supply position of money and takes two types of actions to control inflation (1) Quantitative, (2) Qualitative actions. Quantitative actions like bank rate (Repo and Reverse Repo Rate), Cash Reserve Ratio (CRR) and Statutory Liquid Ratio (SLR) are some important and effective steps.
