Director's Message GST – A Revolutionary Reform in Tax System

In post-independence 70 years old history of India, introduction of GST is one of the biggest and comprehensive reforms in indirect tax system. "One Nation, One Tax, One Market & One Price" is the theme of this tax system. GST has



removed interstate disparities and complexities in indirect tax structure in India. Goods & Services Tax (GST) is not a new approach, it was first introduced in France in 1954. In India it took thirteen years in implementation. In 2003, by the recommendation of Kalekar Committee this tax came into thought and after a long debate finally on 1st July, 2017, it came into force. GST has replaced 17 types of taxes such as VAT, Entertainment Tax, Advertisement Tax, Purchase Tax and State Taxes on Lottery & Betting etc. It is multilevel value added tax. For 0% corruption and free from red tapism, all procedure, forms and registrations are online. Goods & Services are classified in various categories (i) 0% Tax Goods, (ii) 5% Tax Goods, (iii) 12% Tax Goods, (iv) 18% Tax Goods (v) 28% Tax Goods. Average Tax Rate is 18%. It seems no big price hike in goods as nearly 81% goods are taxed under 18% tax slab.

Conclusion : The GST introduction in India is a positive and overall beneficiary step for consumers and suppliers as well as for the nation. Tax network will increase more collection of revenues which will step up the economy of the nation.
