#### **Director's Message**

I express my heart felt gratitude on releasing second issue of Newsletter "Navutkarsh". I wish for the success of this endeavor and hope it will provide a fruitful effect. As it is a usual practice to review on a current economic activity of the country in every newsletter, this time I am mentioning the demonetisation in India.

#### Demonetisation

On 8 November 2016, the Government of India announced the demonetisation of all ₹ 500 and ₹ 1,000 notes of the Mahatma Gandhi Series. The government claimed that the action would curtail the shadow economy and crack down on the use of illicit and counterfeit cash to fund illegal activity and terrorism. Demonetisation would also combat tax evasion by 'black money' held outside the formal economic system. This

step would also make a check on inflation in Indian economy. It is not a new step in India, earlier two times such type of decision had been taken. First time in 1946 and second time in 1978. This move has received support from several bankers as well as from some international commentators.

Arundhati Bhattacharya (Chairperson of State Bank of India), and Chanda Kochhar (MD & CEO ICICI Bank) appreciated the move in the sense that it would help curb black money. It would also accelerate ecommerce infosys founder N. R. Narayana Murthy praised the move. Facts says that demonetisation has broken the back bone of terrorists, nexalites, maoists and anti nation activities in J&K.

Criticism : Nobel laureate Indian economist Amarthya Sen, criticised the demonetisation move calling it a "despotic action". Former Senior Vice-President and Chief Economist of the World Bank. Kaushik Basu, called it a 'mjor mistake' and said that the 'damage' is likely to be much greater than any possible benefits. Pronab Sen, former Chief Statistician and Planning Commission of India member, called it a "hollow move" since it did not really address any of the purposed goals of tackling black money or fake currency. Current economic surveys says demonetisation has hit Indian GDP by 0.5%. Up to 97% of the demonetised bank notes have been deposited into banks which have received a total of ₹ 14.97 trillion. as of December 30 out of the ₹ 15.4 trillion that was demontised. This is against the government's initial estimate that ₹ 3 trillion would not return to the banking system.

Over all conclusion is this that it is a bold step and it will provide a positive effect on economy in long term in future.
